Rural Long Range Transportation Planning Process Starting

Georgetown, SC (August 10, 2023) The Waccamaw Regional Council of Governments is updating its Rural Long Range Transportation Plan (LRTP) to identify the rural transportation needs in Georgetown, Horry, and Williamsburg counties. The process will kick-off with an online survey and a series of public input sessions in each county. The purpose of the LRTP is to establish a vision for future transportation systems in the rural planning area through the year 2045. The Plan will be developed by coordinating with rural stakeholders and the public to identify how the region's transportation system can provide safe and efficient modes of transportation throughout the rural planning area. It will include regional goals for roadways, public transit and bicycle and pedestrian facilities, as well as a prioritized list of projects which would improve the safety and efficiency of these of the region's transportation system.

Since public input is a key element of the planning process, on August 14, 2023, Waccamaw Regional Council of Governments will launch the online survey which will remain open through September 13, 2023. The survey will help pinpoint rural transportation challenges, identify areas which need improvement, and prioritize transportation goals for the region.

The survey data will complement feedback received during public input "drop-ins" conducted in all three counties. Residents and stakeholders are encouraged to attend one of the input sessions (listed below) to assist in the development of the Plan. The public is welcome to "drop-in" to this open-house input session any time between the hours of 5 P.M. to 7 P.M. to learn more about the LRTP and provide feedback on transportation system needs.
