

ENVIRONMENTAL PLANNER

This position will serve as staff for the Council's 208 Water Quality Program and Air Quality efforts, conduct environmental reviews, collect and analyze data, and develop resiliency plans/elements of comprehensive plans and hazard mitigation plans. This position will also provide planning technical assistance to local governments, especially as it relates to flood plain management and water quality planning. The selected candidate will be required to interpret and apply applicable federal, state, county and local codes, ordinances and regulations.

Entry Level Pay Grade 5

- Bachelor's degree in urban planning, civil engineering, architecture, political science, public policy, or related area of study in addition to one year of work experience; or Master's Degree in Planning, Public Administration or related field.

Associate Level Pay Grade 6

- Master's Degree in Planning or Public Administration with emphasis in transportation or urban planning with three years' experience in the planning profession; or a bachelor's degree and five years of professional planning experience.
