

## Notice of Public Hearing Concerning Application

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on Thursday, April 8, 2021 at 6:00 pm the ***Town of Hemingway & Williamsburg County*** located at 110 South Main Street Hemingway, SC will hold a public hearing concerning an application to be submitted to South Carolina Department of Commerce, Grants Administration on or about April 16, 2021, for a Community Development Block Grant. The Town of Hemingway is requesting \$750,000.00 to carry out the following activities.

- The Town of Hemingway proposed project will upgrade the main influent gravity sewer line which serves every customer. The existing gravity sewer line begins near the intersection of Oakland Street and N. Main Street and traverses northeastward towards the Flannigan Branch Pump Station. There is a history of backup and infiltration due to the high water table in the areas near the swamp. The water has caused problems by leaking into the sewer pipe where it is then pumped to the Wastewater Treatment Facility.

This public hearing and the matters to be discussed are subject to the provisions of the ***Town of Hemingway*** Citizen Participation Plan, developed in anticipation of participation in the State of South Carolina's Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program, providing for the participation of the citizens of the ***Town of Hemingway*** in the planning and implementation of community and economic development projects which will involve CDBG funds. The Citizen Participation Plan is available for review at Hemingway Town Hall from 9am-5pm.
